



**The Greater Cincinnati Foundation awards
Weathering the Storm Funding to LifePoint Solutions**
Grant is for youth program

Oct. 14, 2010—Cincinnati, OH—LifePoint Solutions, a merger of Family Service and Clermont Counseling Center, was awarded a \$30,000 grant from the Weathering the Economic Storm Fund, a partnership of funders, managed by The Greater Cincinnati Foundation.

The funds were awarded so that 32 seriously at-risk teens could continue receiving support services that help move them towards high school graduation. In 2001, the youth entered the Friends of the Children program which provides intensive support to our community's most vulnerable children from first grade through high school graduation.

The program's funding was cut in 2010 after the economic downturn caused budget cuts from the program's primary funder, Hamilton County Department of Jobs and Family Services. The Weathering the Storm funds will be used to continue services to the teens, who are now in ninth and tenth grades, under LifePoint Solution's Children and Family Division.
